Phoenix Camera Club Monthly Themes for 2010

January	Humor	Images that make you laugh. Titles will be read for this category.
February	Faces and Hands *	ACCC has not yet published the description for this Theme.
March	Speed	This must be a subject in motion, either mechanical or living, captured in such a way that the image conveys a sense of speed.
April	Field Trips	Images taken on any PCC field trip from April 2009 - March 2010
May	Macro	Focus on making the small big. Use close-up techniques to zoom in on the little things.
June	Sports	From archery to yachting, there are hundreds of sports to choose from. Get out and shoot some sports shots
July	Snow	It's that white stuff that we don't see too often in Phoenix. Make us feel cold.
August	Lines and Angles	Time to get geometric. Man-made or natural, anything that highlights lines and/or angles
September	Humor *	ACCC has not yet published the description for this Theme
October	National Parks	Images that show "America's Best Idea" in all their glory. US National Parks only. No National Monuments, Historic Parks or State Parks. With 58 to chose from, including 3 right here in Arizona, there are lots of options

November	Night Scenes	Any image taken outside after the sun is down. No warm light still visible in the sky. It's dark half of the time. Take your camera out and explore the night. Fill flash or any source of artificial light is OK. Use of rear curtain sync is permitted.
December	Animal portraits (non-domesticated)	Portraits of wild animals. They can be captive, but can't be domesticated animals like pest or farm animals like horses.
